The School is organized by the **Lomonosov Moscow State University, School of Public Administration** in Moscow (Russia) in collaboration with University of Gothenburg (Sweden) and Aalborg University (Denmark) on **May 29-31, 2017**.

The International School **venue** will be located in one of the most green and picturesque areas of the city of Moscow – at the MSU territory (Shuvalovsky MSU building, Lomonosovsky prospect, 27-4).

The **mission** of the International Summer School is to advance excellence in teaching and research of academics and trainers from different educational centers from all over the world to acquire additional expertise and skills in particular sphere of knowledge as well as in pedagogy.

The Summer School in the PA education & training is one that:

- provides insights to different types of teaching techniques
- offers a comprehensive curriculum where participants actively create and/or perform as well as respond to the PA educational processes
- disseminates best individual practices and expertise between participants
- helps build a network of personal and professional contacts.

The **main goal** of 11th Summer School is to explore the contemporary challenges associated with migration and integration. School's **program** will focus on the following topics:

- Differing societal understandings of what constitutes migration / integration challenges and appropriateness of solutions
- Migration as historical phenomenon
- New challenges and threats in managing migration
- Inclusion of migrants
- Media communication and discourses of migration
- Competence profiles of civil servants involved in managing migration processes
- The development of appropriate course materials in the form of syllabus, assessment exercises and feedback matrices, targeted pedagogical techniques and readings.

11th Summer School key experts:

Professor Gregg Bucken-Knapp



Professor Bucken-Knapp is currently the transnational scientific coordinator for the European Commission DG-Justice funded project, "Welcome: Policies for EU Migrants" that examines the urban governance responses in six European cities (Amsterdam, Brussels, Copenhagen, Dublin, Gothenburg and Hamburg) when it comes to the challenges associated with the integration of EU migrants.

Bucken-Knapp is also a member of the Swedish research team (based at the University of Gothenburg) in the Joint Projects Initiative - Urban Europe financed project "IMAGINATION: The Governance Dynamics of CEE Migrant Integration".

Professor Trine Lund Thomsen



Associated Professor Thomsen is currently leading a research project "The impact of labour migration from Central and Eastern European countries to the Danish labour market" investigating changes, challenges and advantages of labour migration from CEE countries, using both quantitative and qualitative methods. Her research in the field of migration has during the last 6

years resulted in an anthology, 4 book chapters and 7 peer review journal articles.

Professor Martin Bak-Jørgensen



Associate Professor Bak-Jørgensen at the department of Culture and Global Studies, Aalborg University. He is affiliated with the COMID (Centre for the Studies of Migration and Diversity) research group is the author of 31 publications including the book "Solidarity without Borders: Gramscian Perspectives on Migration & Civil Society Alliances".
